

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type blade carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type forks can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
